

About viewing and hearing scores on this site

As technology has changed and improved, so has our creation of scores for this website. The following variations are presently in use on the site.

See the music. Low resolution tiff files that any computer can quickly open. These files are gradually being phased out and replaced by one of the two types listed below.

See and hear the music: Scorch. Our latest, and by far, best entry of scores onto our website. You can see the complete score; if you wish, you can hear a computer generated sound version of the score as it scrolls along, measure by measure, and system by system. The files do not support printing—they are only for online viewing.

About Scorch

Scorch is a widely used Sibelius invention (Sibelius is a music notation software program). The files on our site were created with Sibelius 5; Scorch 5 is necessary to view them. Scorch is a free download—open a “see and hear the music: Scorch” file and you will be led to the download site.

System requirements for using Scorch at our site

Windows: Windows XP SP2 or Windows Vista, Internet Explorer 6 or later, Mozilla Firefox, Netscape 7 or later, 20MB hard disk space.

Mac: OS X:10.4 or later, Safari, 20MB hard disk space.
